

## Ebooks & E-audiobooks for Kindle Fire Tablets

### Compatible Formats:

- OverDrive Read ebooks
- EPUB ebooks
- MP3 e-audiobooks
- Kindle ebooks (with Kindle app)

### What you need

- The OverDrive app
- A library card

1. Download the OverDrive app from one of the following:


- Amazon Appstore
- [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com)

2. Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in. If you're under 13, select **I am under 13 years old** instead.


**Note:** If you're using a first generation Kindle Fire, skip this step and move on to step 3.

3. Find the Longview Public Library's collection in the OverDrive app. On most Kindle Fires, you can do this by swiping from left to right to open the **Home menu**, then tapping **Add a library**. On first generation Kindle Fires, tap the  icon

(or, if you don't have this icon, go to *Menu > Get Books*).



4. Tap the star icon  next to the library to save it to your library list.



5. Borrow Titles

Tap Washington Anytime Library from the 'Get Books' list.



Find a title to borrow by tapping one from the home page or running a search. Tap a title, then click **Borrow** to check it out. If prompted, sign in using your **entire** library barcode number.



After clicking on Borrow, your bookshelf opens, displaying title(s) you have checked out. From here, you can tap **Read** to start reading eBooks in your browser.



Or, select a format from the **Download** drop-down menu, then tap **Confirm & Download**.


*If available, you can also select **Kindle Book** (US libraries only) to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the title to your Kindle reading app.*

When you are ready to read a downloaded title, return to your bookshelf. Tap the **Menu** button, then **Bookshelf**. From there, tap a title and enjoy.

**\*Note:** *If you're using a first generation Kindle Fire, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete.*

## Returning Titles Early

From your app bookshelf, tap and hold a title to display the return options.



You can **Return** a title to your library, which also deletes it from your device.

You can **Delete** a title from your device, but you will still have it checked out to your library account.

### To Return Kindle Books

1. Go to Amazon and **Manage Your Content and Devices**.
2. From **Your Content**, select the **Actions** button next to the book that you want to return.
3. Select **Return This Book**, and then select **Yes** in the pop-up window.
