

# E-audiobooks for your iPod With a Mac

If you have an iPod touch, please follow the instructions for **Apple iOS**. For all other models, this guide will help you get started.

## Compatible Formats:

- MP3 e-audiobooks

## What you need

- An iPod cable to plug into your Mac
- OverDrive for Mac
- A library card
- iTunes v9.1 (or newer)

## Install software

Install OverDrive's app on your computer (<http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/>) You'll need it to download audio titles and transfer them to your iPod.

## Borrow and download titles on your computer

Go to Washington Anytime Library:  
<http://anytime.lib.overdrive.com>

Find an available title to borrow. Click on a title, then click **Borrow** to check it out. If prompted, sign in with your **entire** library card number.



Your bookshelf opens, displaying title(s) you have checked out. Click on the Download icon.



## Transfer e-audiobooks to your iPod

Open OverDrive on your computer.  
Select a title then click the **Transfer** button.



When the Transfer Wizard opens, connect your device to your computer using the USB cable then click **Next**.

Make sure your Apple device is selected under 'Player'. Once it's detected then click **Next**.



The transfer begins.



If you see the following message, use the instructions to enable 'Manually manage music' on your Apple device.



### How to set the 'Manually manage music...' option in iTunes

Open iTunes. Connect your Apple device using the USB cable. Select your device from the upper right-hand corner of the iTunes window.



Check the **Manually manage music and videos** box in the 'Summary' screen.



Click **Done** in the upper right-hand corner. When completed, click **OK** to close the prompt. This will take you back to the Transfer Wizard.

Click **Cancel**, then start again at Step 2. (This is only necessary if you had to change the 'Manually manage music...' option.)

When the transfer is complete, click **Finish** to close the wizard.



### How to find audiobooks transferred to your iPod

You'll find transferred audiobooks in your playlists or under 'Music'. Select a title, and enjoy.
